Thank you for your letter of 3 May 2021 addressed to the CEO, Ms Emma Thomas, seeking clarity in relation to how the feedback received during the current engagement process for the mass transit project will be incorporated in the final Options Analysis report. On behalf of the CEO, I provide the following response.

Information provided on Council's mass transit website and in related communication material advises that the outcomes of the community and stakeholder feedback about the mass transit options will inform the final Options Analysis report, which will be considered by Council later this year.
