

WHEN WILL THE COMMUNITY HAVE ITS SAY?

"Council has revealed when the community will get to have a say on the future of built form and height along the proposed light rail corridor.

A Sunshine Coast Council spokesman said "the detail of built form and height will be developed with community input over the next few years as part of the detailed business case development".

Mass Transit Action Group's Tracey Goodwin-McDonald said the group couldn't find any mention of increased population or housing densification along the light rail corridor in a 2014 report which was used to consult with the public about preferred route options.

Ms Goodwin-McDonald said the public consultation in 2014 was limited solely to light rail and route options, and didn't give any indication that it would be accompanied by increased housing densification.

She called on Mayor Mark Jamieson to **kickstart community engagement now.**"
